

"Bicycles were invented 200 years ago" "Elephants are found in Africa and Asia"

Specific groups/things in an explicit context.

"The people from my work recycle" ** WATCH OUT:

** WATCH OUT: explicit context.

Social groups as a whole.

"People,Women, Children, Men, Boys, Girls, etc..." "People are happier at Christmas"

Unique things.

"The Sun; The moon; The People; The internet" Uncountable, plural & abstract things "Happiness is all

that matters"

Newspapers.

The Independent"

Illnesses

Superlatives. "The biggest; The best; The worst"

Magazines "Do you read Cosmopolitan magazine?"

National groups. "The English are a mixed race"

Already mentioned things. "There's a boy running in the park; The boy is wearing a red t-shirt"

Hotels, cinemas and theatres.

"The Ritz, The Odeon, The Opera House"

Dates "The 10th of October"

Expressions:

- At home / Go home.
- In / To class.
- To / In / Into / from church.
- To / In / Into /Out of prison, hospital, bed.
- To / At / From work.
- For / At / To breakfast,
 lunch, dinner.
- By car, bus, train, plain ...
- By chance, accident.
- On foot.

*** WATCH OUT !!! Some roads have "the" in their own name. eg: "The 5th Avenue" "The Beeches"

A AN

Singular, countable things. "A paper" "An Elephant"

* WATCH OUT! If it has alread been mentioned, we shall need to use "the".

A: I'm watching a horror movie.

B: Did you enjoy the movie?

(A turns into the because we had already mentioned it)

In English we always fit "a/an" before professions. It's something you don't do in many other languages (not in Spanish or French, for example) so it's hard to remember, you must be careful and pay attention.

"She's a doctor"

"He's an architect"

"She's an accountant"



A AN

Certain numbers: A hundred / A thousand /A million.

"A hundred and twenty"

"A thousand two hundred and eighty six"

"A hundred thousand"

Certain expressions: Such a / What a..../
A pair of.... / A good /nice time... /
A range of...

" It's such a beautiful day"
